Lily O'Dell finished 3rd U19 (at age 14) in the Junior Long Course Triathlon at Tenby in Wales. The race had one discipline per day for three days and comprised a 2km sea swim, a 72km hilly bike and a 10km hilly run. Lily was also 4th 14year old in the National Youth 10mile Time Trial Championships in Norfolk; qualified at Darley Moor for the GB U20 team at the 2019 European Duathlon Championships, Transylvania, Romania; won bronze at Ironkids in Zell-am-See, Austria; was 1st lady in the Rutland Water 500m open water swim; and was first youth girl at the Epping Aquathlon.

Ruby O'Dell was first U9 girl in the Essex Mountain Bike League and second in the Eastern Region Mountain Bike League

At Strathclyde Park, Glasgow, *Lotti Knights* (9th), *Kathryn Bell* (10th) and *Liam Bell* represented Great Britain in the European Sprint Distance Triathlon Championships

In the European Championships in Ibiza, representing Great Britain, *Lotti Knights* finished 4th in Aquabike and *Sasha Vail* 9th in sprint duathlon

Elizabeth McCluskey won silver in the Eastern Region Open Water 1km Swimming Championships. In the Castle Open Water Swim Series, she was first lady in the 1mile Lough Cutra, Ireland race, 5th lady at Castle Howard (1km) and 6th lady



at Hever Castle (1.9km)

Peter Cooke was U20 bronze medallist in the European Sprint Duathlon Championships in Soria, Spain. *Peter* also finished second overall in adult sprint triathlons at Chelmsford, Norwich, Kimbolton and Newmarket and was third in St Neots

Lily O'Dell won bronze at Ironkids Zell am See, Austria and had a top 10 finish in Ironkids Maastricht, Holland

Ryan Howe came 1st TS2 and *Beth Irving* 2nd Youth in the East London Children's Duathlon
